

3 Easy Steps to Basic iOS Enrollment

With Moki, you have total control over your devices at any given time.
Here's how iOS Basic Enrollment works with Moki's MDM platform.

STEP 01



Device Setup

- Open your device and navigate to the **Start Screens**.
- Skip the Apple ID & Passcode.
- Enable **Your Location** to see device location in **Total Control** (do not send diagnostics).
- Open settings and navigate to **Display & Brightness** > **Auto-Lock** > **Never**.
- Go back to the **General** screen and navigate to **Accessibility** > **Guided Access** and toggle to set a passcode.
- Important: Once you've completed the steps above, go to the iTunes section & log in (you won't be able to install the apps if you don't).

STEP 02



Device Enrollment

- Generate your Enrollment Code under the **Enroll** tab in Moki.
- Open Safari on your device.
- Navigate to **MokiManage.appspot.com/start**.
- Enter the 7 character enrollment code and click **Go**.
- Click **Install** > **Profile** > **Allow** > **Close**.
- Once you see enrollment confirmation, go to device Settings and click **Install** > **Install** > **Trust** > **Done**.
- Once the MDM profile is installed, all apps will be installed on the device.

STEP 03



Lock the Device to Your App Using Guided Access Mode

- Open your desired app.
- Click the **Home** button on the device quickly, three times.
- The **Start** or **Resume** options will pop up in the top right.
- The app will then be back to full screen and locked to your chosen app.
- To exit **Guided Access Mode** you must click the **Home** button three times, enter your password and click **End**.

Basic iOS Enrollment is not typically the recommended enrollment option. For more device control and all MDM features, use Supervised Device Enrollment or Apples Automated Device Enrollment program.
